Trimethoxyvinylsilane (CAS: 2768-02-7) is classified as a skin sensitiser category 1B (Skin Sens. 1B) according to Annex VI of Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 based on vivo data with laboratory animals. However, no allergic reactions were observed after occupational contact. Mixtures with trimethoxyvinylsilane (up to 5% active substance) in polymers of different viscosities were tested in the "local lymph node assay" (OECD 429). None of the mixtures showed a sensitising potential. This result serves as the basis for our expert assessment, taking into account the entire composition when classifying and labelling polymer mixtures.
